1. Remove the plastic fairings from the subframe and drill the factory marked holes. You can watch a thorough demonstration of this process on our YouTube channel.



2. Remove the left side factory foot peg using a Torx 40 socket and wrench.

3. Install the left side pannier rack.



4. Insert the supplied M8x40mm bolt through the front tab and the M8x35mm bolt through the rear. Use T30 torx socket. Only one or two turns to keep both bolts loose.

5. Re-insert the factory foot peg bolts. Only one or two turns to keep the bolts loose for easier installation.



6. Repeat step 2 on the right side and then mount the right side pannier rack. Repeat step 4 on the right side as well.

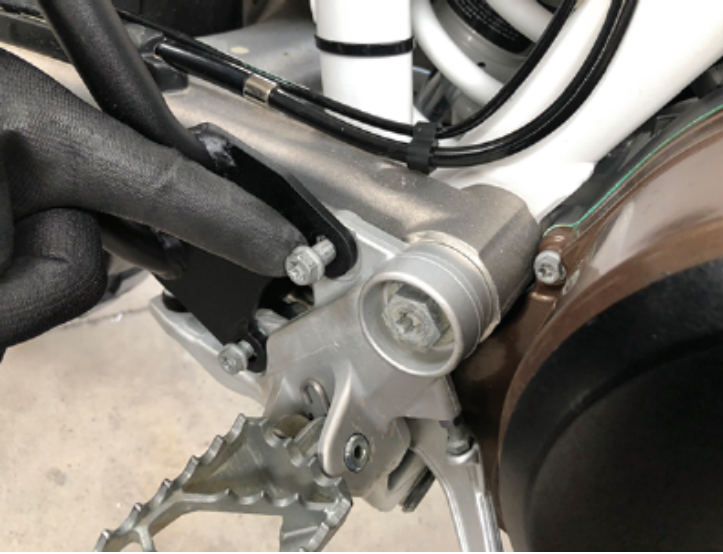

7. Re-insert the factory foot peg bolts.  
Only one or two turns to keep the bolts loose.



8. Mount the rear cross brace. Please make sure that the cross brace's tabs end up between the pannier frames' tabs.

9. Insert the supplied M6x20mm bolts and hand-thread the locking nuts. Do the same on the opposite side as well.



10. Tighten all four nuts by using two 10mm wrenches and/or 10mm socket and ratchet.

11. Finally, go ahead and tighten all the bolts and nuts to torque specs and make sure to check again after going out for a test ride.
